for her daring rescue of a robin high in a tree who was dangling by her foot.

Emily, who is 13 years old, climbed the tree by first standing on the shoulders of her mother, who was standing on a ladder propped against the tree. Then she crawled out to the end of the limb and clipped the string that held the little bird captive. Expecting the bird to be injured, she was happily surprised when the bird immediately flew away. Emily then removed all of the string so another bird wouldn't suffer the same fate. Hooray for Emily and her Mom, Heidi.
